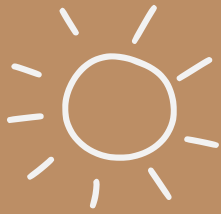

Direction from the airport

If you arrive in Pristina by plane, you can take the public transport Bus "1A" to "Cathedral Mother Teresa".

From there, continue walking in the direction of the main square, Mother Teresa, for 10 minutes. The hostel is located on the opposite side of the Swiss Diamond Hotel (above "Shabani Grill").

The entrance to the hostel is at the back of the building, so please follow the signs located near the hostel for guidance.

*Please check the timetable for the departure of the buses from and to the airport on the official website,
www.airportpristina.com/public-transport.

- Cost: 3 EUR/Person (One Way)

Public Transport

If you take a taxi from the Airport, ask the taxi driver to take you to the Mother Theresa Statue.

The hostel is located in the building on the left side of the statue. Please follow the signs for the hostel and look for the "Prishtina Center Hostel" sign on the streetlight post.

Please note that the entrance to the hostel is located on the back side of the building.

- Cost: Around 20 Euros

By Taxi

From Main Bus Station

The best way to come to the hostel from the bus station is to take a taxi and just ask the driver to take you to the Mother Theresa Statue.

-Cost of taxi: From outside the station, 3 euros; from inside the station, 5 euros.

Shopping Malls

Albi Mall

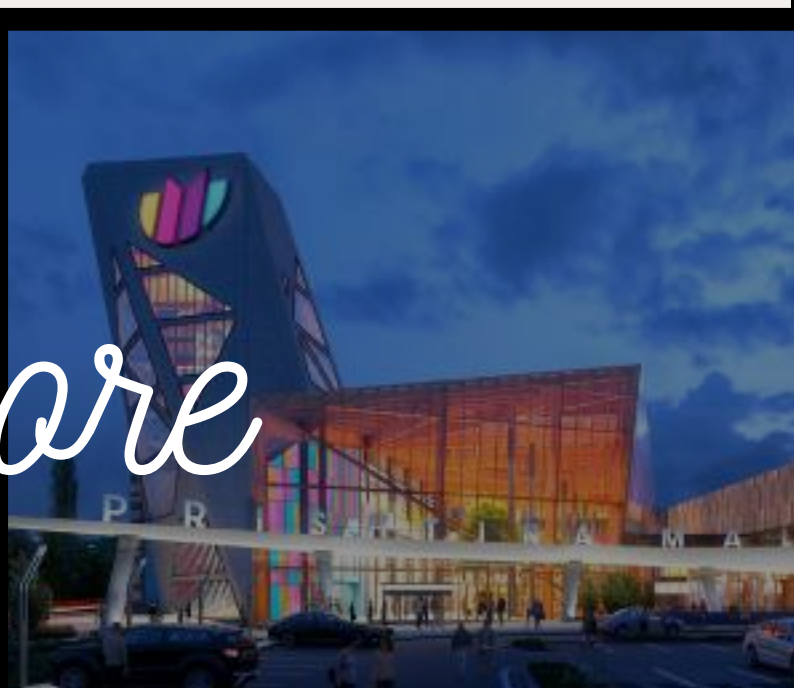
This shopping mall is located approximately 5 kilometers away from the city center. If you want to buy clothes and spend time at the shopping center, it is a good place to visit. Additionally, there is a cinema called "Cineplexx" located there.

A taxi ride to the shopping center would cost around 5-6 Euros, or alternatively, you can wait for the bus "24 Yjet" just in front of "NEWBORN".

Prishtina Mall

The Prishtina Mall is the newest and largest sector-leading shopping and entertainment mall in Southeast Europe. The mall is approximately 12 kilometers away from us, and the only way to get there is by taxi.

A taxi ride should cost around 10 Euros per one way trip.

Two Dialects

Albanian has several dialects divided into two main groups: Gheg, spoken in the north of the country, and Tosk, spoken in the south.

Nowadays, the two dialects are slowly mixing, a process started during the Communist regime when the old elites began to speak Tosk in order to blend in with the rest of the population.
